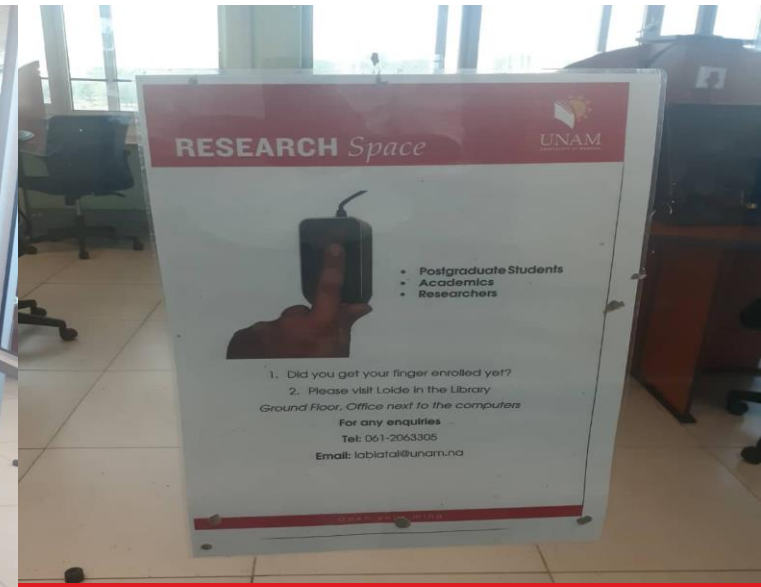
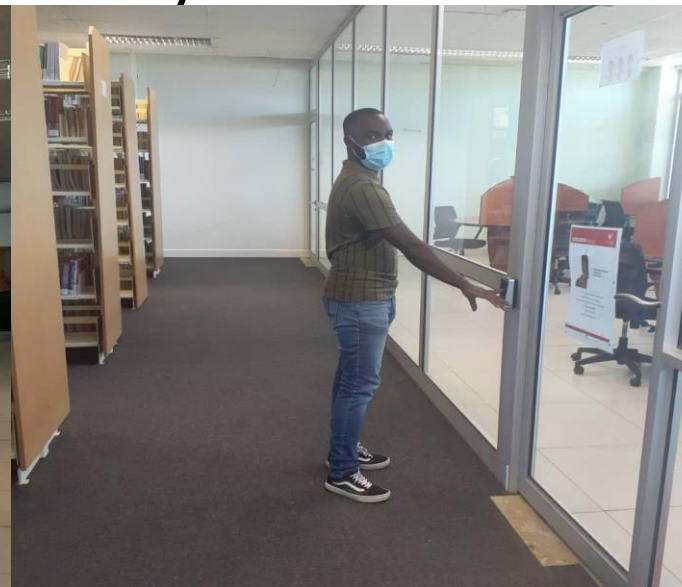


Any **c**hanges will be posted at service points and on the library web site.

- Library Borrowing privilege: 10 books for 30 days. Always have student Card OR Proof of registration. Borrowed books can be renewed at the library and online see video tutorial at: https://unam-na.libapps.com/libguides/admin_c.php?g=1118042&p=8153412
- Access to Post graduates research common lab which is located at 2nd floor of the library for post graduate students only. Students need to register their thumb figure in the system to be able to access the lab



- The lab is equipped with computers, space for research and studying using your own device and full internet and wireless access, research books to use while working on the thesis, dissertation, journal articles and book chapters, photocopier printer and scanner.
- Access to research data analysis software for quantitative (SPSS), AND Qualitative (Atlas ti.) provided by library IT, and available in some of the computers in the lab.
- Access to library physical books: Books are arranged with Dewey Decimal Classification System (DDC) base on subject area. Search the library catalogue to find and locate books in library shelves. - Access to Ebooks, Journal articles and other information sources is available digitally by searching the library World Catalog Discovery platform at library website:





- We will soon start with weekly training workshop for post graduates focusing on research process AND scholarly communication on: searching and reviewing literature sources: systematic review, narrative/traditional review, and bibliometric analysis; Institutional Repository (thesis & dissertation, publications from UNAM researchers, and research data repository to be introduced soon) ; Google Scholar; referencing and citation and using citation management tool (Mendeley); copyrights; Open Access publishing (article processing charges APCs), research impact, authors profiling etc. Scival, Scopus; Open Researcher & Contributor Identifier (ORCID); using UNAM Urkund plagiarism detector software; Research funding platform; searching Namibiana digital collection etc.
- If you can not find a specific fulltext article/chapter= Interlibrary loan document sharing system is available to get it from national, regional and international networks.
- UNAM library APA Referencing style tutorial guide is completed and will be soon circulated to post graduates.
- We are also busy developing a library guide for post graduates to be published and marketed once completed.
